Thank you to all of you who joined us for our annual sports days. I know your children loved having you there and we loved seeing so many faces!

Please take note of all the dates in these final three weeks of the academic year. As both schools are closed next Wednesday and Friday due to industrial action, the children's reports and information regarding their new teacher and transition will come home to you next Thursday (6th July).

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School Improvement Development Plan

Aim 1: Quality of Education:

- Teaching for Learning is accurately pitched for children to make at least good progress.
- This is evidenced in the non-core subjects.
- Assessment is accurate and effective
- Teachers have consistently high expectations for all.

Aim 2: Quality of Education

- **Reading:** Introduce and embed a new phonics system
- Increase the love of reading (North Elmham)
- **Maths:** Introduce White Rose teaching materials into KS2 in both schools, embedding vocabulary and consistent practices throughout the Federation

Aim 3: Leadership and Management

- Develop middle leaders to effectively lead their subject area and have consistently high expectations for all.
- SEND children are accurately identified and accurately provided for and they make good progress.
- A clear and thorough induction process
- A rigorous attendance system

Aim 4: Personal Development

- Ensure pupils have a strong voice and high expectations for themselves.
